Support Ministries

We are also fortunate to have a full-time youth minister, Serena Tankersley, working for the MC, and administrative support minister, Debbie Bartlett. Seventy Jacob Blakesley volunteered to be the Mission Center Invitational Support Minister (MCISM). They provide communication, outreach ministry, planning and support that greatly help move the MC forward.

The FMC Council, comprised of members from around Florida, meets online regularly. They bring insight, give voice to how the Holy Spirit is moving throughout Florida, and help shape what the MC is to become. We again affirm that God and God's purposes are sure and will not fail.
